Membership Policy: (as outlined in Singer Handbook)

- **Parent Participation** is a requirement of all members of DGC; if you do not fulfill your volunteer duty you will be charged a fee of \$75.
- **Tuition** is due on the 1st Wednesday of each semester (September and January) and is non-refundable. A \$15 late fee will be assessed for late payments after the 10th of the month. There are no refunds.
- **Punctuality** is an expectation. Singers must be on time for all rehearsals and performances.
- **Attendance** is vital to the success of DGC. Absences must be reported in a timely manner and should be kept to a minimum. More than 2 absences will jeopardize a singer's participation in the next concert. It is expected that every singer will participate in all three concerts.
- **Sheet Music** is the property of DGC; you will be charged for damaged or lost music.
- **Behavior** of all singers must reflect a respect and courtesy towards instructors, staff, parents and fellow singers at all times.
- **Commitment** to standards of excellence is a shared goal by instructors, staff, board members, parents and singers.
- **Board Members** are always available for questions and concerns via the choir line.

**Code of Conduct Agreement
Danville Girls Chorus
2011-2012**

Danville Girls Chorus should be an enjoyable experience for everyone participating. Therefore, there are several basic guidelines which must be observed by ALL members. Please read the following rules carefully. **Please return a copy signed by the choir member and a parent.**

RULES OF CONDUCT

1. **Have a "Pleasant and Positive Attitude."** Attitude and participation are vital components to a successful choir experience. Always be cooperative and give 100%.
2. **Be Courteous.** At all times, choir members are to be respectful of their fellow singers and follow the guidance of their directors, classroom helpers and board members. Choir members must also display special courtesy and respect toward Charlotte Wood Middle School teachers and staff who graciously allow us to use their facilities for our weekly rehearsals.
3. **Be respectful and willing to "Stop!"** DGC operates under the Golden Rule and climate of respect. If someone says "Stop," then you must stop whatever action is unacceptable to others -- without question or complaint. DGC has a zero tolerance policy towards bullying.
4. **Safety first!** Choir members are to act in a manner which respects the safety of the group and the rights of their fellow choir members.
5. **Be Punctual.** Promptness is vital if rehearsals are to run smoothly. Remember: "ON TIME IS LATE"
6. **Illegal Substances/Cigarettes.** No choir member will consume or have on their possession any illegal drugs, alcohol or cigarettes. Any girl found to be in position of any of these will be sent home immediately and will face disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from participation in DGC.

These rules are set forth to help everyone enjoy a happy and safe choir experience. We know that you will make every possible effort to follow these guidelines. However, the following should be clearly noted: **if a Choir Member is in violation of any portion of the DGC code of conduct, the behavior will be addressed by Mr. Abrams or the President of the Board. If the same type of behavior is addressed 3 times, DGC reserves the right to dismiss the singer from Danville Girls Chorus.**
